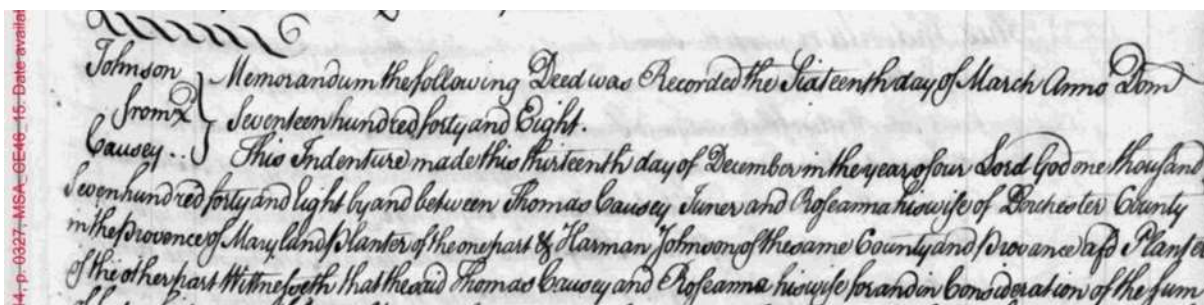


The Sons of Nehemiah

Nehemiah was a well-respected name in the Causey families of Dorchester/Caroline County, Maryland in the late 1700s. Our Patriarch Thomas Causey-I (1690-1776) had sons Nehemiah, Thomas Jr., William, and Solomon. Before Thomas-I died in 1776 he had already lost two of his sons Nehemiah and Thomas Jr. His sons Solomon, William, and Thomas Jr. all had sons named Nehemiah. For clarity Nehemiah son of Thomas-I we will label Nehemiah-I; Solomon's son Nehemiah-II; William's son, Nehemiah-III, and Thomas Jr.'s son Nehemiah-IV (see CauseyClan.com [The Book of John Causey](#)). Thomas Causey-II, Jr. had at least three sons: Zebulon, Thomas the 3rd, and Nehemiah. James, Joseph, William and John may also have been his sons as all were associated with Nehemiah-IV in Guilford County, North Carolina. Nehemiah-IV also named one of his sons Nehemiah who would then be Nehemiah-V.

Nehemiah-IV was born about 1754. He is first listed on the US Census in Guilford County, North Carolina in the 1790 US Census. His father and mother Rosannah Hubbard Causey were married before 1748 when they sold land in Dorchester County.¹ On the 1800 US Census of Guilford County, North Carolina Nehemiah Causey Sr. is listed as N. Cossey – Age-Over 45. Therefore, born before 1755. Nehemiah Causey-IV would have been born no earlier than 1748 nor later than 1755.²



After the death of their father and grandfather Nehemiah-IV, Zebulon, and Thomas-III all migrated south to Guilford County, North Carolina. I must add that there were many others of the Thomas Causey-I branch who moved to Guilford and Randolph Counties, North Carolina, and there is confusion as to which generation some of them belong. For example Aaron Causey³ is almost certainly a son of Thomas Causey-II based on names of many of his descendants but there is but one mention of him in the annals of Guilford County. The remainder of this story is about Nehemiah Causey-II and his sons and grandsons especially Robert and Thomas.

Thomas Causey came with his father Nehemiah and family to Guilford County, North Carolina before 1790. The 1790 US Census Nehemiah shows a family with 4 sons and his wife and 2

daughters. The sons were Robert b. c1774, Thomas b. c1778, William b. c1780, and Nehemiah Jr. b. c1788, and

probably Joseph Causey (who witnessed two land deeds to Thomas Causey in 1800). Thomas is shown below on the US Census for 1800 in Guilford County, North Carolina. His brother Robert is on page 619, two pages earlier. Following are a series of notes I extracted from old records on Genealogy.com

“Robert and Thomas were sons of Nehemiah, but don't know if there were other siblings. The only children we know of that were Robert's were an Isaac and Nellie. Nellie married Benjamin Eaton Powell (s/o Eaton Powell and Holly Adams - Eaton's first wife). Nellie was born in KY, but if you look at where Clarksville is, I believe their land spanned the borders of KY and TN. It was probably where Ft. Campbell, KY is located now. Isaac eventually moved to Fayette Co. IL as well and there was testimony from him listed in one of the county's genealogy quarterlies called, Fayette Facts. He said that he was the son of Robert Causey, and that Robert and Thomas were brothers. We don't show that Thomas had a daughter named Mary, so we have pretty much concluded Mary was another daughter of Robert's. Thomas and his wife, Polly moved up to Fayette Co. IL and there were probate papers on them after their death which named all their kids. I've never been able to find a death on Robert, though. Robert was born in 1776, so could have had a daughter in 1803. This Causey family had originated in Caroline Co. MD and moved down to Guilford Co. NC. They were part of a group called Nicholites. This faction (which was an offshoot of Quakers) started in Delaware and spread to MD. A group went down to Guilford Co. NC. Nehemiah was a part of that group. Our Mary Causey was born 1803 in NC (probably Guilford Co.)”

“Thomas moved to Montgomery Co, TN from Guilford Co, NC. He moved on to Fayette Co, IL around 1837. We have a marriage of a Nellie Causey to a Benjamin Eaton Powell that followed this same migration. According to a bio on an Alex Myatt in Bond Co, IL, Nellie was the d/o (daughter of) Robert Causey and she was born 1805 in KY. ... Benjamin E. Powell and Nellie (Causey) Powell were living next to Thomas and Polly Causey on 1850 census in Fayette Co, IL.”

One item of correction to the enumeration of the children of Thomas and Polly Swift Causey. The last child listed "Polly" is actually a grandchild: "Mary 'Polly' Bone" the daughter of Moses Bone and Ann Causey. Mary is my great great grandmother; her first husband was John Lincoln Baggett; following his death from typhoid fever at Bethel, Tennessee, in 1862 during the Civil War (he was in Co. D. 49th Illinois Infantry Volunteers), Mary Polly remarried in December of 1863 to Samuel Hunter (incidentally, her uncle John Wesley Causey was the minister who performed her second marriage) and Samuel adopted her three children: Mary Elizabeth (my great grandmother), James Mosely, and John L. although all three children retained their Baggett surname. Subsequently, the family moved to Indian Territory which in 1907 became the state of Oklahoma. Samuel Hunter died in March of 1918; Mary Bone Baggett Hunter had preceded him in death, dying October 10, 1914 in Tuskahoma, Oklahoma. Both are buried at the Old Town Tuskahoma Cemetery near the original capital of the Choctaw Nation.

Thomas W. CAUSEY [1140], was born abt. 1774 in , Caroline County, MD; and died 1 Dec 1857 in , Fayette, IL. He married Mary or Polly Ann SWIFT [1141], who was born in 1781 in , MD; and died in 1860.

Notes for **Thomas W. CAUSEY**:

Item: DOC #CAUS047 (Fayette Facts, Vol. VIII, No. 1, Dec. 1979, p 70-76) a history of Fayette Co, IL by Fayette County Genealogical Society, Box 177, Vandalia, IL 62471. **Came to IL in 1833**, probably in the company of the William Hubbard family. Three of their children were married to Bones, three to Hubbards, children of William Hubbard, son of Peter, the Revolutionary soldier. Thomas Causey was in the 1830 census of Montgomery Co, TN. In Illinois, his land was in section 19 and 20 in Bear Grove Twp. He had 45 acres in Sec 19, NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 and the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4, 80 acres in Sec. 20, which is where the Causey cemetery is located. His death date was taken from his estate record in Fayette Co. According to the estate papers, there were heirs living in Montgomery, Bond, and Madison counties, but they were not identified. According to the statement of their grandson, they came to Illinois in 1833. Thomas appears in the 1830 census of Montgomery Co, TN. In his household at that time was a very old man. Whether that was **his father Nehemiah** or not is not known. The list of children was taken from the petition to sell real estate in Thomas Causey's estate papers, and with the recollections of his grandson.

Cheryl, hello cousin! I got away from genealogy but am now back into it, and I just found your message. I would be happy to swap Causey family information with you. I just recently bought a 2nd copy of your Great Grandfather Vivian Whitlock's book about the family - found it in an antique store here in Oklahoma. My brother, sister and I have done quite a bit of research about the Causey family. Just last night I discovered some more information by my great grandmother Addie Causey Fees, daughter of G.W. Causey - she lived to be 99 years old and lived with my grandparents (her son) in the family home built by her husband Hiram Newton Edgar Fees in Guthrie, OK. Her brother T. L. "George" Causey was the famous buffalo hunter, and their brother Bob was the famous blacksmith and spur maker. In her young adult years she was quite a character in her own right, being a friend of Carrie Nation and an

equally strong abolitionist. She wrote about the "demon drink." There are Causey family members in Oklahoma City and El Reno, Oklahoma, including two people who enjoy family history research.
